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Paul Kent is a highly-respected Australian sports journalist, author, presenter and producer, who is considered a leading authority on rugby league in this country.

Paul is currently a Senior Sports Columnist for *The Daily Telegraph*, one of several roles he has filled since joining *News Corp* from *Fairfax Ltd*. While at *News Corp*, he has also undertaken roles as diverse as a two-year post as their European Correspondent in the company's London bureau and, as a Senior Writer, covered stories as diverse as the conflicts in both Iraq and Lebanon, Victoria's Black Saturday bushfires, the earthquake in Sumatra and the mine disaster in New Zealand.

Throughout his 25 years as an eminent journalist Paul has also gained national recognition covering Olympic Games and World Cups in rugby and soccer and in 2009 was named Feature Writer of the Year at the News Awards.

In his current position, Paul is co-host and producer of Fox Sports *NRL 360*. He makes regular appearances on national television, is part of the *Triple M NRL Team* and is a presenter on Sky Sports Radio's *Big Sports Breakfast*.

Paul has penned two critically acclaimed books to date – *Johnny Lewis: The Biography* and *Sonny Ball* – the latter of which was a finalist for the 2015 William Hill Australian Sports Books of the Year.
